A Scenario-Based Disaster Response Exercise

September 9-11, 2016

Operation Premonition is a Leadership Coordination, Command & Control, and Inter-operability training exercise.

This exercise is a simulated cyber attack on the nation's communications and power infrastructure. AmRRON operators will establish communications networks to receive and share news and information about the developing situation.
